While the story line of the song is a little folksy, the underlying philosophy of the song serves as a model and message for our lives. Don't give up on your quest to climb your personal mountains of life, and follow your dream.

Kilgore immortalized his uncle, Clifton Clowers, in the song. Clifton Clowers was born in Conway County, Arkansas, on October 30, 1891, and died there on August 15, 1994, at the age of 102. He is buried on the mountain. He became a legend as a result of the popular song.

He was the youngest of five children of Thomas Jefferson Clowers and Mary Prince Clowers. He was a World War I veteran and a member of the Mountain View Baptist Church where he was a deacon for many years. At the time of his death, he was survived by three sons, two daughters, 15 grandchildren, four step-grandchildren, 27 great-grandchildren, 14 step-great-

Merle Kilgore was born in Chickasha, Oklahoma, on August 9, 1934, and was raised in Shreveport, Louisiana. Kilgore went on to a career as a country music recording artist but had great success as a songwriter, co-writing with June Carter the song *Ring of Fire*, and performed by her husband Johnny Cash. Kilgore died of congestive heart failure on February 6, 2005, at the age of 70.

February 5, 1923, in Keithville, Louisiana, near the city of Shreveport. At a young age, he was interested in music but his primary interest was athletics. He was offered a baseball scholarship to the University of Idaho. King returned to Shreveport and joined a TV and radio show produced in Shreveport and broadcast throughout the United States, often appearing on the same shows with Elvis Presley, Tex Ritter, Johnny Cash, Hank Williams, Johnny Horton, Jim Reeves, George Jones, and many others. King left Gotham Records in 1973 after achieving 29 hits. He now resides in Louisiana at the age of 87.

Woolverton Mountain and Clifton Clowers may be part of American music folklore, but they are real.
