

## Ferriello gets winter sand bid after lower bidder's sand is too rocky

WINDSOR— The Windsor selectmen opened their August 17 meeting by appointing Tom Reed to the planning board.

Next they opened the sand bids from six different contractors. Farley and Son Landscaping had the lowest bid, but their sand was too rocky. The selectmen directed road supervisor Keith Hall to check out the pits where Frank Monroe and Nathan Northrup would get their sand. Paving bids were also considered. The selectmen dismissed Mariner's bid because on project four they only calculated for 240 ton of asphalt, while all the other bidders calculated 700 - 800 ton. The selectmen deliberated a long time between RC Paving and Ferriello whose bids were only \$98 apart. The selectmen finally decided to go with the Ferriello's lower bid of \$235,124.

The selectmen also opened salt bids from three different companies. They directed the town manager to ask the companies to send a sample and find out the time frame of delivery.

Under public comment Mary Ellen Peaslee asked the selectmen to take a new vote over appointing Jerry Nault to the planning board. The previous vote had failed with a vote of 2:2. Selectman Jonathan Adams was not present at the first vote, but had since arrived. Peaslee said she felt the selectmen did not vote regarding experience and ability, but on personality. Tom Reed also asked the selectmen to reconsider. He said he appreciated being voted on the planning board, but he has zero experience.

"When somebody in town has the expertise and can be an asset to the town, they should get the job. Jerry is one of the most qualified people in town willing to be on the board. I am withdrawing my name. I can't sit on the board when there is a volunteer more qualified."

Selectman Marty Dow said he has nothing against Jerry, but he was told Nault said if the selectmen wanted him to be on the planning board, they would have to come ask him personally.

"I'm not going to get down on my knees and beg."

Selectman Ray Bates pointed out that never in the history of the board has the board gone out and personally asked someone to be on the board. Bates also added that being a citizen of the town is the only qualification to serve the town, "you don't have to carry a special degree in the front door to be qualified."

Selectman Ronnie Brann said that he decided to run for selectman because he kept hearing the people of the town "were sick and tired of the out-of-towners coming in, saying the town is so nice and in six months they want to change it."

Brann explained that when

Nault's term expired on the planning board, the selectmen appointed him as an alternate and appointed former selectman Ed Hubbard to the planning board because Hubbard said he wanted to stay involved in town government. Hubbard can no longer serve on the planning board because of family. The selectmen voted three to two to appoint Jerry Nault to the planning board.
